Some basic procedures:

Awards will be made only to Berkeley PIs. Funds may be used to support UCB or TAU travelers, with reimbursement entirely managed by the Berkeley PI.

Travel must be completed by December 31 2025.

The visits should include an informal or formal public seminar; please notify CCB or Safra Center well in advance so they may advertise.
